Joseph (Genesis 37)

Week 1

Brite Idea: God is in control.

He Question: What does God have control over?

Because God created everything, He is sovereign, or in control, over all of creation. There is nothing outside of His control. God works through the world to bring about His will.

We Question: Can we trust God when things don't go our way?

Bad things happen because we live in a broken world. We may not understand why things happen, but we can trust that God has a plan, He is good and He is in control.

Week 2

Brite Idea: God will forever be God.

He Question: How long has God existed?

God has always existed and will always exist. He was before everything and He has no end.

We Question: Can we live forever?

God loves us and wants us to live forever with Him. When we trust in Jesus as our Savior by seeking His forgiveness and allowing Him to be Lord of our lives, we can have eternal life.

The Wilderness (Exodus 16-17:7)

Week 3

Brite Idea: God provides for us.

He Question: How is God able to give us what we need?

God created everything and everything belongs to Him. He loves us. He knows what is best and provides what we need.

We Question: How do we ask God for what we need?

God wants us to pray and talk directly to Him. We can pray by praising Him, asking forgiveness for sins, and asking for what we need.

Tabernacle (Exodus 25-27; 40)

Week 4

Brite Idea: God dwells with us

He Question: Where is God?

God is everywhere, all the time. He isn't limited by space or time like we are. He isn't limited to a building. He chooses to be with His people all the time.

We Question: Why does it matter that God is with us?

We know that we are never alone. God is with us through every situation, giving us His strength, wisdom, and guidance. He loves us and is always with us.
