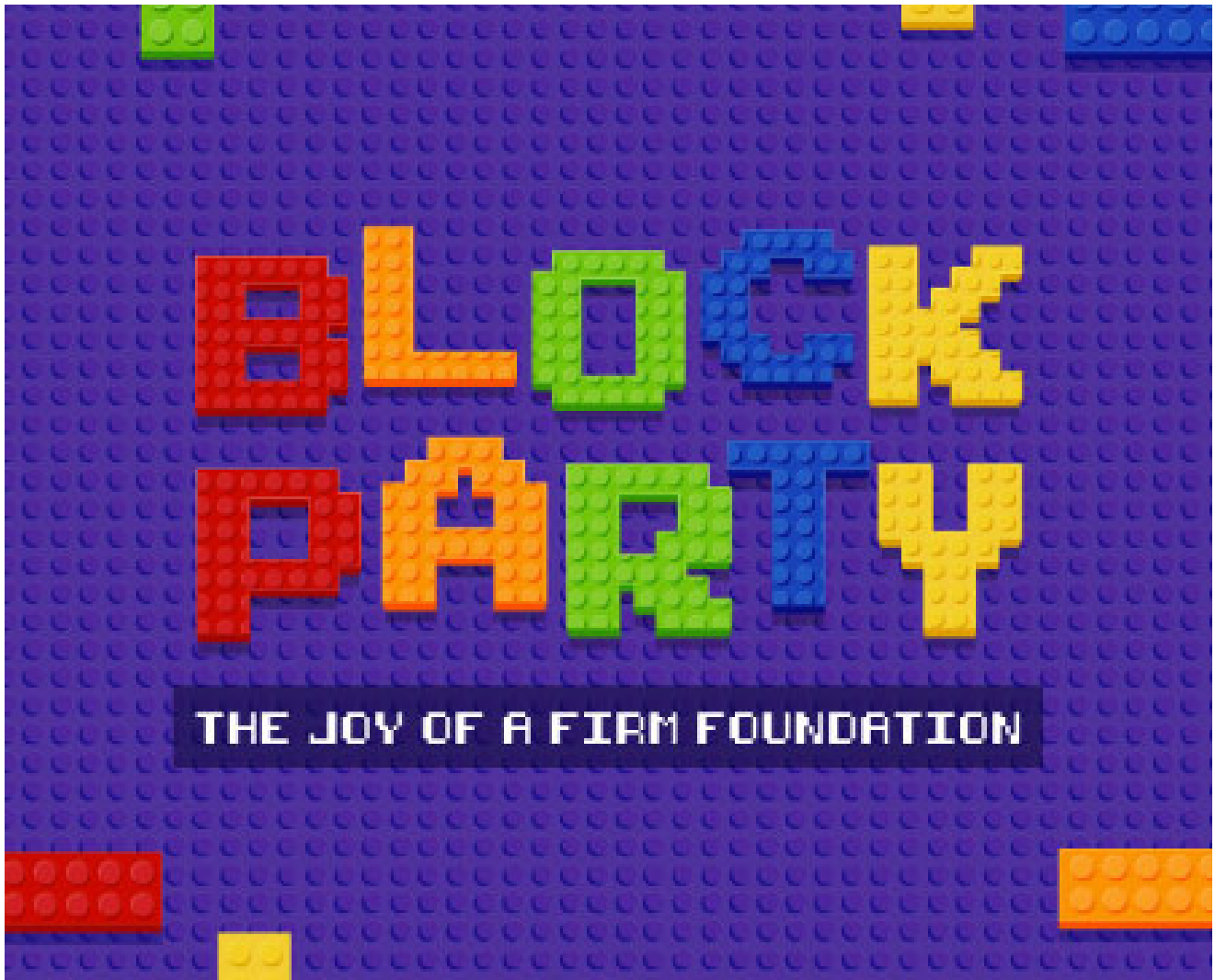

### Block Party Curriculum

**Tagline:** The Joy of Building on a Firm Foundation

**Memory Verse:** “But I trust in your unfailing love; my heart rejoices in your salvation.”

### Lessons:

#### A Little Fishy

**Scripture:** Mark 1:16-20, Jesus Calls His First Disciples Jesus went around looking for people with a little bit of faith to leave everything behind and follow Him. Jesus took a group of fishermen and built them into his first disciples.

**Objective:** Kids will learn “Putting your faith in Jesus builds a great new life.”

#### U-Turn

**Scripture:** Mark 10:35-45, James and John’s Request to Jesus The world’s “wisdom” is that you are important and that you should put yourself first. But Jesus tells us – just like he told James and John when they wanted important positions – that the most important thing is to serve others and put them first. That’s God’s Truth.

**Objective:** Kids will say “God’s Truth is: I should put others first.”

#### Move Mountains

**Scripture:** Matthew 17:14-21, Jesus Heals a Boy The disciples wondered why they were unable to drive out the demons that controlled a young boy when Jesus was able to take care of it right away. Jesus said they lacked faith. Even a little faith can have big results – like moving mountains!

**Objective:** Kids will learn “Just a little faith in Jesus can move mountains.”

#### Bring the House Down

**Scripture:** Luke 5:17-26, Jesus Forgives and Heals A group of men had a friend who could not walk, but they had faith that Jesus could heal him. They were willing to go to whatever means necessary to get their friend to Jesus. Their faith reminds us that we should get rid of anything that keeps us from getting closer to Jesus.

**Objective:** Kids will learn “Nothing should come between us and Jesus.”

## SERIES OVERVIEW

### **Believing Is Seeing**

**Scripture:** Matthew 8:5-13, The Faith of the Centurion In Jesus' time, Romans were considered outsiders by the people in Israel. One Roman Centurion had faith that Jesus could heal his sick servant. His faith was so strong, he knew that Jesus could perform a miracle even without going to the sick servant. Jesus praised this "outsider" for his faith and told the "insiders" that they should try to be more like him.

**Objective:** Kids will learn "No matter who we are, we can put our faith in Jesus."

### **One Way**

**Scripture:** John 14:1-11, Jesus is The Way to the Father The world's "wisdom" says that there are many ways to enlightenment or peace or God. But Jesus revealed that the only way to get to God the Father is through Jesus. That's God's Truth.

**Objective:** Kids will say, "God's Truth is Jesus is the ONLY way to be saved."

### **Road Closed Ahead**

**Scripture:** Luke 6:43-45, Tree and Its Fruit, Philippians 4:8 & Psalm 101:3-4, Choosing Good Things The world's "wisdom" says that what we look at and play on our screens can't do us any harm. But what we see with our eyes goes into our hearts. And Jesus tells us that the fruit of our life is based on the condition of our hearts.

**Objective:** Kids will say "God's Truth is: I should fill my heart with good things."

### **Merge to the Right**

**Scripture:** John 15:1-8, The Vine and the Branches The world's "wisdom" is that you are strong enough to do it all on your own. But as Jesus told his disciples, if we want to do great things for God, we have to stay connected to Jesus and rely on his strength. That's God's Truth.

**Objective:** Kids will say "God's Truth is: I need Jesus."

### **Cross Paths**

**Scripture:** Luke 23:36-43, The Thief on the Cross As Jesus hung on the cross, the people mocked and jeered at him. But one man – a thief who hung beside Jesus – recognized that Jesus was the true King and Savior. Despite the terrible conditions, the thief put his faith in Jesus. . . and was rewarded with paradise with Jesus.

**Objective:** Kids will learn "If I put my faith in Jesus, I can have eternal life!"
